Health & Human Services

- Sort and package food at food banks
- Serve food at church, soup kitchen or shelter
- Make no-sew blankets for the elderly or sick
- Organize a food and toy drive
- Host holiday parties and make crafts with shelter residents
- Visit with residents at a veteran's hospital or nursing home
- Participate in Special Olympics

Animals & Environment

- Graffiti removal
- Tree, shrub or flower planting
- Storm drain stenciling
- Collect pet food and donate to shelters
- Start a dog-walking group with friends for elderly neighbors

Civic & Community

- Serve as a Teen Leader/Mentor for other Girl Scout Troops
- Organize your own project for your neighborhood, town, church or school
- Be an intern for a nonprofit
- Organize a trash pick up day.
